



GOL has reached another milestone in its voluntary restructuring process. The U.S. Bankruptcy Court has approved the "Bar Date Motion", which, among other things, sets the final deadline for individuals and entities to submit claims against GOL in its chapter 11 cases ("Bar Date"). The Bar Date has been set for June 14, 2024.

We recommend careful review of the attached communication (in Portuguese and English with the same content), which contains important information about the Bar Date and instructions for submitting a claim form. Consider consulting your attorney for any necessary guidance.

As is typical in chapter 11 cases, GOL intends to send notice of the Bar Date to all GOL employees, suppliers, and other third parties who have, or have had, a relationship with the company.

Receiving this notification does not necessarily mean you have a claim or that GOL or the Court believe you have a claim against GOL. If you do not believe you have a claim against GOL, no further action is required.

If you believe you have a claim against GOL and intend to file a claim in the Chapter 11 process, carefully read the instructions in the attached communication. Steps must be taken in a timely manner to ensure that the forms are received by the Bar Date. Any amounts to be included in the claim must be in U.S. dollars, and the conversion rate should be based upon the applicable conversion rate as of January 25, 2024.

We are pleased with the progress we are making in our Chapter 11 process. We will continue to keep all parties informed and communicate further significant developments as we progress in this process.
